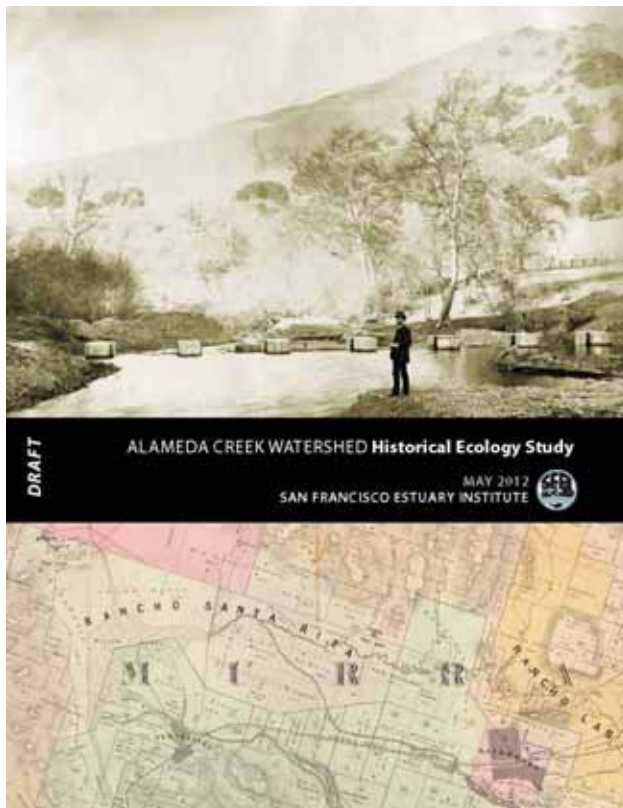
Alameda Creek Alliance Annual Membership Dinner
