However, the description of the program and its elements has not changed since its inception. RMP staff have asked Dave</li> <li>Ceppos to prepare a proposal outline the cost to develop charter documents (e.g., representation, decision-making methods, document review, etc.). An alternative to this proposal is for RMP staff to develop these documents on our own.
